

NORTHERN EXPRESS LEFT THE TRACKS CLOSE TO MATHESON

Carried German Prisoners for
the Kapuskasing Intern-
ment Camp.

North Bay, Jan. 27. - The Temiskaming and Northern National express No. 9, which left Toronto on Saturday night was derailed near Matheson, Ont., on Sunday night, owing it is thought to a broken rail. Twelve cars left the track but no one was injured. The private car of General Manager Hinton, of the Grand Trunk Pacific, was attached to train also special cars containing a number of German prisoners, en route to Kapuskasing internment camp. The road was cleared in five hours.*
