

PROTESTS TO OTTAWA AGAINST DEPORTATION OF WINNIPEG AUSTRIANS

A protest against the deportation of 10 Winnipeg aliens, which occurred Monday as announced in Thursday's Tribune, was telegraphed to Ottawa today by T. J. Murray, attorney for the prisoners.

Friends and relatives of the men, who were rounded up after the strike riots and interned at Kapuskasing, Ont., are indignant because they were deported without trial and without any information regarding their disposition having been sent to Winnipeg, Mr. Murray said.

He expressed the opinion that the men, because they were Austrians, probably were sent back to Austria.
