

NEW JAIL WILL BE BUILT BEFORE THE NEW COURT HOUSE

ACCOMODATION FOR PRISONERS NEEDED

Before Present Jail Can be
Torn Down to
Make Room.

Hon. W. H. Hearst, prime minister, informs the Star that tenders for the new Court House will not be called for immediately as the new jail will have to be erected first in order to provide accomodation for the prisoners when the present jail is torn down to make way for the new court house.

The new jail is to be located on McNabb street at the head of Blake street. The property, which about 200 feet square, was transferred to the government for a jail site in return for a site for the armory on the Alber street frontage of the court house

Although Hon. Mr. Hearst did not say so, it is expected that work on the jail will be commenced soon.
