STICKS AND STONES IN FREE-FOR-ALL FIGHT

One Man Had to Have His
Wound Dressed at the
Hospital.

As the result of a free for all scrap in the West End yesterday morning three Russians were fined 20 and costs with the option of six months in the Central Prison by Magistrate Elliot today. The three who were fined were Sam Botluk, Harry Maluk and Byl Borashavick. There were anywhere up to a dozen engaged in the battle, in which stones, lumber, knives, etc., were employed as weapons, and everyone seems to have got hit two or three times. One man, Fred Arnish, was cut so badly he had to be taken to the hospital to have his wound dressed. The principal witness was Fredor Bohycuk, who came along just as the row started.
