

# Sault Russians Caught By Bolsheviki Cult

Some Illuminating Documents Showing the Lenine-Trotsky  
Propaganda Which Helped the Kaiser Ruin  
a Great Country

The evidence given in the City Police Court in the case of the King vs. Wasy Enchuk, known in police circles as the "Bolsheviki" case, has demonstrated that the Russian Revolutionary Society, which plunged the Russian people into a seething torment of murder and pillage, is spreading its poisonous influences among the foreign population in Canada.

The true character of this dangerous propagandist, which is doubtless linked up with the German government and with their tools Lenine and Trotsky, in Russia, is fully established by the following extracts from documents produced in the Police Court by the Crown upon the prosecution of Enchuk.

(1) "Workers life is a real misery and wretchedness, beside that, high taxes are growing because the Government needs the money for new armies and battleships. . . . The soldiers are shooting them, the Courts of Justice which are on the side of the Capitalists, are punishing them with heavy sentences, and then they are tortured in the gaols, whenever a capitalist has a desire for

"more land or property for his own relatives, big classes of workingmen are mobilized and sent to kill each other. The profits from factory production are extremely high, and goes into the Capitalists' pocket, and the poor workers are soaked with their brother's blood, and dying for the Capitalists' benefit.

"For useless bread eaters—all the wealth.

"For the workers—bones to pick."

"The worker is compared to a dog living in a filthy kennel and tied on a chain, who has no freedom, and has to depend on his master's charity. Therefore workers all over the world get united and try your best to suppress your worst enemy, the Capitalists."

(2) "The same struggle is still existing and will end only when all the workers will be organized and united, and with their real pretence and interest and social revolution power will overcome all authorities all over the world." "Then when victorious and all ruling classes, capitalists and religion are defeated, then will the poor working classes prosper, and en-

"joy the benefit."

"For to reach this scope we are trying our best to organize revolutionary society, whose duty is to fight equally the authorities, capitalists, and religion."

"They have to introduce to the workers revolting spirit to the workers," because this is the main aim of "the Socialistic Society."

(3) "Organize yourselves for to fight against Capitalists, if you do not want to see your wives and children in misery, organize yourselves for the coming fight for only your welfare, and for to destroy the Capitalistic reign."

The accused Enchuk, gave evidence on his own behalf; and stated that he was secretary of the branch of this Revolutionary Society organized in Sault Ste. Marie in April 1918, and admitted having the literature produced in Court. He further stated that the society met sometimes in Polupchuk's store, and that George Alexander was present at meetings, also that John Iwano, was a member of the Society.
