

REPORTS INDICATE MEN WON'T STAY IN THE LUMBER CAMPS

Lumbermen Back From Overseas Looking for City Jobs

Ottawa, Nov. 3.—Reports received by the Government employment bureau from all parts of Canada indicate that there is great difficulty in getting men to go to the lumber camps this season or to remain when they get there. One large operator is asking for a thousand additional men, others are in a like predicament.

It seems that most of the lumbermen who served overseas and have returned to Canada are demanding city jobs or none, despite the fact that wages for lumbermen have doubled.
