

On Friday a number of citizens wended their way to the exhibition grounds where a wireless outfit had been erected under government supervision. At first it was thought that the "Germans were in our midst," but this fear was soon dispelled. This wireless outfit was being tried out between the government and the manufacturers, a Montreal firm. The apparatus was so constructed that it was easily transported from place to place, the generator, the transmitter and receiver being encased in strongly built boxes, and so constructed that they could be thrown across pack mules. The time consumed for its erection on the field would probably consume about thirty minutes. Communication was effected with a station at the armory building, Cartier Square, Ottawa. The machine was removed on Saturday. — Watchman.
