

A train containing the 500 Austrian and German reservists to be harbored at Petawawa camp during the winter passed through the C. P. R. station here at 4 o'clock this afternoon. With the reservists was an armed guard. The men will be given work at Petawawa during the winter making improvemnets, etc., to the camp and will be paid twenty-five cents a day and their board. A permanent guard of 125 men will be employed at the camp to watch them.
