

Work on the approach to the bridge over the Petawawa river at the entrance to the military camp was stopped on Saturday and things there are now at a standstill. This work was rendered necessary by the raising of the bridge and was being done by the Ontario Government by arrangement with the Militia Department at Ottawa, but the strike among the prisoners, who were working under the provincial staff, upset the plans made and now the Ontario officials are waiting to see what the Militia Department is going to do about it. It is probable that some arrangement will be arrived at, however, so that the work can be proceeded with. The strike among the prisoners at the camp has not been broken and they are pursuing the even tenor of their way, quite elated over their victory. Their privileges have been considerably curtailed, and they are taken out for exercise every day at the camp, but they apparently have no intention of resuming work.
