

ARRESTED NEAR CAMP

Photographer Went Too Close to Home of Interned Aliens

A letter was received yesterday by Staff Inspector Gregory, of the Morality Department, from Luke Russell, a photographer of scenery for Canadian and American magazines, who is being held in the internment camp near Burk's Falls as a suspicious character. According to the letter, Russell was taking photographs of the scenery in the Burk's Falls district, and ventured too near the military encampments. He was arrested by the guards, and his camera confiscated.

Russell is an Irishman, formerly an inspector of the Toronto Humane Society, and asks the inspector to send along a certificate of good character. This the officer has stated he will do.
