

# GUILTY OF ATTEMPT TO COMMIT TREASON

**Wealthy Farmer Named Snyder  
is Convicted by Jury at  
Welland.**

Welland, Ont., April 8.—“Guilty of an attempt to commit treason in an intention to assist alien enemies to leave Canada, but not realizing the seriousness of his act,” was the verdict of the jury in the high court here yesterday in the trial of Joseph Snyder, a wealthy farmer, living along the Niagara river. In this case, as in that of Nicoloff, tried on a like charge Tuesday, the Crown only asked for a conviction on attempted treason. A reserved case was granted that an appeal might be carried to the court of appeals on the question of law. Snyder was released under \$20,000 bail. Nicoloff, found guilty of attempted treason, was sentenced yesterday to serve one year in prison.
