

# IMMIGRATION MEN ON THE JOB

Bridgeburg, Ont., Aug. 16.—A neat piece of work was consummated by the Canadian immigration officials at this port on Saturday, when J. H. Stratton of Hamilton, charged with defrauding another Hamilton man of \$700, was arrested as he stepped on Canadian soil. Stratton was formerly a real estate agent in Hamilton, and it was there that he met a man named Adam Cook, whom he, so the Hamilton police declare, defrauded. He succeeded at that time, however, in getting to the States and showed a clean pair of heels to the pursuing officials. Later it was learned that he was in New York, and the United States government was asked to return him. Therefore he was brought to Niagara Falls, N.Y., and departed via Buffalo to Bridgeburg where he was nabbed the moment he put his foot on Canadian soil.
