

Under Assisting Aliens Act

Todor Mehil, Austrian, was taken off the train Sunday night by Inspector Donohue of the immigration department for examination and a receipt for \$500 was found on him, which had been sent to Austria from Buffalo. He was taken to police headquarters, and the provincial police got busy and arrested three other Austrians in Thorold. They were Vasele Sperwezan, John Hutton and George Magerson. They claimed that the money was to send to friends in Austria to bring them out here.

They were charged in police court last night with violating the law against assisting the enemy, and were remanded until Feb. 7. This morning Officers Greenwood and Kelly took the four men to Welland, where they will be kept until their trial.
