

HELD IN TORONTO

Owing to Large Number Now Imprisoned at Fort Henry.

Owing to overcrowding of Fort Henry, Kingston, says the Toronto World, Germans under arrest are being housed at the Toronto barracks. Although only three foreigners are being detained there now, it is expected that early next week will see the number increased to 15.

One of the most recent German arrests is Carl von Bimberg, a university graduate and reservist. At the outbreak of the war he was in London, England, and came to Toronto without a permit from the English authorities. The police allege that his father was killed in South Africa when fighting for the Boers.
