

# A RIMOUSKI MAN IS GERMAN OFFICER

## Wilhelm Brubecker Was Sent to Kingston For Intern- ment.

Montreal, June 1.—The Government alien registration department here had under their charge Wilhelm Brubecker, a German, and general manager of the Price Brothers Paper Pulp Mills at Rimouski, who was sent to Montreal by the police of that district, on suspicion of his acting as a German spy. Registration Chief C. J. Ogden, K.C., caused investigation to be made by Inspector Rioux, and amongst other matters brought to light was the fact that Brubecker is an officer in the German army, that he has been in the German army, that he has been in Canada three years only, and that certain circumstances connected with his residence here are suspicious.

He was taken to Kingston for internment.
