

LETTER REVEALS PLOT AGAINST KINGSTON, ONT.

KINGSTON, Ont., Feb. 12—Augustus Prager, an Austrian, is in trouble here. It is alleged that he wrote a letter to a resident here, but the missive went to another man of the same name, who, seeing its serious nature, drew the attention of the post office authorities to it. The latter informed the chief of police and military headquarters, with the result that a warrant was issued for Prager's arrest.

The letter, it is understood, stated there were many friends of the Teuton cause in Kingston, and that an endeavor would be made to get together to strike a blow at the city. Col. Sherwood, chief of the Dominion police, has been notified.
