

MONTREAL UNEMPLOYED IN DANGER OF BEING DEPORTED TO EUROPE

Montreal, July 4.—That thousands of the unemployed in Montreal are in imminent danger of being deported to Europe as a solution of the out-of-work problem was frankly admitted by the immigration authorities here yesterday morning. The drastic measures which W. D. Scott, immigration superintendent at Ottawa, has adopted, namely, to deport all foreigners of less than three years' residence in Canada who are out of work and are charges or have been charges of the community, has been specially inaugurated for the benefit of Montreal and other large cities. The local immigration agent states that he will probably round up the hordes of unemployed in the city and they will be deported *holus bolus*.
