

# MANY FOREIGNERS LEFT OTTAWA FOR MONTREAL TO-DAY

Over three hundred Poles, Ukrainians and Austrians left the Central station by an early train this morning for Montreal.

A visitor to the city from Montreal who would not disclose his name to The Journal, when seen at the Chateau Laurier this morning, stated that while wandering round the docks in Montreal yesterday afternoon he was attracted by a large crowd assembled on the wharf at the foot of Ottawa street where a ship with steam up lay moored. In his opinion she was a small grain boat: she was nameless and her deck was thronged with a crowd of about 500 foreigners.

From what he could pick up from the conversations around him it seemed that the boat was bound down the river. The general opinion was that the boat would be allowed to leave the port of Montreal but would in all probability be held up at Québec or Halifax.
