

## GERMAN SPIES IN MONTREAL, SAY LETTERS

Montreal, Aug. 11.—Chief Campeau, of the Montreal police, has received three letters from citizens, informing him of secret meeting places of Germans, suspected to be spies. One of the rendezvous is on the south shore of the river, and has been frequented for the past six weeks. Since war has been declared meetings have been held every two days. Among those identified, according to the correspondents, are employees of leading city hotels. Chief Campeau has communicated with Col. Sherwood in Ottawa, who will turn them over to the military authorities.
