MONTREAL, Aug. 15.—Chief Campbell, of the police force of Montreal, said today that everything would be done to see that natives of Germany or Austria were not molested so long as they remained quiet, but if they showed any evidences of creating trouble they would be promptly arrested and kept in detention until such time as the war is over or they were released by the military authorities.
