

EDMONTON IS POINT OF REGISTRATION

**Germans and Austrians of District
Must Record Their
Names Here**

OTTAWA, Nov. 1.—In accordance with the recent order in council passed by the government various points throughout the Dominion will be officially designated registration centres for the registry of Austrians and Germans. Already Montreal has been so designated, and the registrar, S. H. Carpenter, Commissioner of Police in the Interior Department, and formerly chief of detectives in Montreal, and police chief in Edmonton, has been appointed registrar. In addition to Montreal registration bureaux will be established at Ottawa, Sydney, Fort William, Winnipeg, Regina, Calgary, Edmonton, Vancouver and probably at other points, if found necessary.

It is possible that arrangements may be made in the west whereby Germans and Austrians living long distances from the point of registration may be enabled to take out their parole without the necessity of going to the bureau.

Only such men as are believed to be strictly dangerous will be interned, others will be placed under surveillance.
