

# FOR HOSTILE ALIENS

## Gen. Otter and Mr. Silas Carpenter Here to Enforce Registration

Major General Otter, who is to have charge of the work of registering and looking after the hostile alien population of Canada, was in Montreal yesterday in connection with this work. General Otter visited the Divisional Headquarters, and had a consultation with Colonel Fages, acting O.C., and other officers as to the means that had best be adopted in Montreal, which is the main centre of foreign population in Canada. It was stated that no definite plans regard-

ing the registration of aliens had been decided upon, since the organization for enforcing the new regulations had not been perfected.

Mr. Silas H. Carpenter, who was for many years chief of the Montreal Detective Service, has been appointed to take charge of the work here, and is making preparations. It is expected that within a few days the plans will be completed, and the work of registering hostile aliens, and dealing with those who need close supervision, will be started.
