

## TO ROUND UP ALIENS.

### Gen. Otter Will First Make a Tour of Registry Offices.

MONTREAL, Nov. 5. — Maj.-Gen. Sir William Otter, former inspector-general of Canadian militia, who has been appointed by the Federal Government to direct the work of carrying out the order-in-council respecting "alien enemies," with headquarters in Toronto, was in Montreal yesterday, and with Silas H. Carpenter, the registrar of alien enemies, in Montreal, visited militia headquarters in Union avenue.

Asked as to his plans, Gen. Otter said he was going to make a trip of inspection throughout the Dominion, and was commencing at Montreal. Until he had looked into matters he could give no outline of the plans to be adopted to carry into full effect the intention of the Government to safeguard the country and the Empire from the possible danger due to the presence of thousands of Germans and Austrians in the Dominion.
