

TRANSFER ALIEN FOES

Men Interned at Montreal to be Sent
to Petawawa Camp

(Western Associated Press.)

MONTREAL, Dec. 2.—The first batch of alien enemies interned in Montreal to go to Petawawa will leave tomorrow morning, 100 being transported there under the charge of Major Gale. The remainder will be interned at Tarent, near La Tuque, on the Lake St. John railway, about 800 miles from the city in the northern part of the province. Guards will be provided from the Montreal regiments and the Germans and Austrians interned there will be put to work clearing the land and constructing roads, receiving winter clothing, food and shelter from the government in addition to twenty-five cents a day for their labor. The first batch of men will go there probably in three days.
