

TRIO HAD DYNAMITE

Said They Took Explosive From Austrians' House

Although Detectives Sloan and Desroselliers scoured the north end of the city yesterday afternoon and last night, they were unable to locate the Austrian house where Harry Cook, James Martin and Pierre Lafleur claimed to have obtained fourteen sticks of dynamite which were found in their possession. The trio were arrested in a Craig street saloon by the detectives after a 'phone call had been received at headquarters stating that three men were exhibiting large quantities of dynamite. When arraigned before Judge St. Cyr yesterday morning, the men claimed to have taken the explosives from an Austrian boarding house in the north end. When the three were released on suspended sentence the detectives took one of them along to point out the house, but up to a late hour last night the suspected stronghold of alien enemies had not been discovered.
