

IS ARRESTED FOR HELPING ALIENS TO CROSS BORDER

Montreal Cab Driver Appears Before Montreal Police Court

MONTREAL, July 26.—A Montreal cab driver, Albert Harden, appeared in police court from information laid by Major Dale, provost marshal of this district charging him with "inciting and assisting subjects of foreign states at war with his majesty to leave Canada without the consent of the crown." It is stated that Harden has been soliciting and carrying Austrians and Germans across the border to the United States. He charged a stated fee and the men were taken in an automobile along unfrequented roads at night, and across the border, via the eastern townships. Harden was remanded until Wednesday.
