

ASSISTING ALIENS TO LEAVE CANADA

Montreal, Sept. 17.—With the arrest of three men, suspected of having aided enemy aliens to get into the United States from Canada, the police think they have broken up a gang engaged in this profitable pursuit. Inspector George Rioux made the arrests at Huntingdon and Valleyfield, assisted by Special Constable George Porteous.

J. B. Francoeur, alias Hart, one of those arrested, is reported to have acknowledged the shipment of 111 Austrians. Alex. C. and Johnny Lefebvre, brothers, are also held.

The usual methods were followed, viz.: payment of money, a secret rendezvous and an automobile and a drive at night, with all lights out, at full speed across the border. It is said that one Austrian went over disguised as a nun.
