

INTERNED AT AMHERST, N.S.

Prisoners Taken When High Flier Sank Kaiser Wilhelm Der Grosse, Brought to Canada.

Halifax, June 7.—Two hundred and ninety-seven Germans, prisoners of war, most of them members of the crew of the converted cruiser Kaiser Wilhelm Der Grosse, which was sunk on the west coast of Africa, August 20, by H.M.S. High Flier, arrived here on the steamer Halifax from Jamaica, yesterday. They were taken to the concentration camp at Amherst.
