

AMHERST INVESTIGATION

U.S. Consul May Be Asked to Look Into Situation

Ottawa, August 24.—The Canadian authorities are losing no time in acting on the threat of German reprisals on Canadian prisoners for alleged ill-treatment of Germans interned at Amherst, N.S. It is probable that the American consul at Halifax or Moncton will be asked to investigate the situation and forward his report to Berlin through the American Embassy there. A report is also being obtained from the officer in command of the Amherst internment camp.
