

INSPECTING ALIEN CAMPS IN CANADA

Calgary, Aug. 26.—Major General Sir William Otter, inspector of aliens for the Dominion, arrived in Calgary this morning at the close of a tour of the fifteen interment camps throughout Canada. Although inclined to be reticent, Sir William stated that 5,000 of the 7,000 prisoners were at work and that with the exception of the one outbreak and attempt to escape on the part of the crew of the Kaiser Wilhelm Der Grosse at Amherst, no trouble was being experienced at the camps. The internees, he added, are being well fed and clothed, and on the whole are satisfied with their lot. The fifteen camps stretch all the way from Amherst, N.S., to Nanaimo, B.C.
