

# GERMANS CAUGHT

Only One of Aliens Who Escaped at Amherst Unaccounted For.

St. John, N.B., Jan. 20.—Sergt.-Maj. White and three men from the detention camp at Amherst, N.S., passed through here at noon today for Amherst, in charge of three men of the twelve Germans who escaped last Monday night. The three Germans are Schaeffer, Valner and Kehuel. They were caught at McAdam, N.B. Kehuel is suffering from frost-bite, both feet being bitten.

Two officers and eleven privates of Siege Battery A, located here, left this morning for St. Stephen to bring back the four escaped Germans re-arrested there, and, if possible, the four taken in Calais, Maine.

It is said on authority it is known that Wagner, the only one of the twelve escaped prisoners still unaccounted for, has gone into the United States, but that his whereabouts is known.

## Become U.S. Citizens.

Calais, Me., Jan. 20.—Four alleged German prisoners of war, who escaped from a detention camp at Amherst, Nova Scotia, and were detained here yesterday after crossing the border, were formally admitted to the United States today. A board of special inquiry decided they were able to fulfil the immigration requirements. The men gave their names as Gustav Hartwig, William Schroeder, George Klienworth and Hans Nen.
