Quiet Restored Among Interned
Aliens and Ringleaders Sent
Back to Amherst

St. John, N. B., July 14.—Since some interned Germans and Austrians were brought here a few days ago from upper Canada to work in the coal mines at Minto, forty miles inland from here, there has been trouble. It became so serious this week that troops were sent from St. John. Quiet was restored and six ringleaders arrested. These have been sent to Amherst internment camp.
