

7 PRISONERS ESCAPE BUT ARE RETAKEN

German and Austrian
Prisoners Had Short
Lease of freedom--
Caught Near Windsor

Another batch of seven German and Austrian prisoners escaped from Melville Island military prison Monday night, but they have all been recaptured and brought back to the city.

It is not generally known how the septette got to the mainland. Their absence was soon noted, however, and word sent to the military outposts, with the result that during the night or early morning, the seven were retaken, near Windsor Junction, by the military outposts stationed above Bedford. They were without funds and were following the railway tracks. They were brought back to the city yesterday.
