

Some Looting Going On At Halifax But Not To Any Great Extent

HALIFAX, N.S., Dec. 11.—

The police have been warned to look out for a man who speaks with a German accent, who is suspected of looting among the ruins here. It is claimed that this man offered assistance to a man searching his house for a cash box. The stranger located the box which had contained \$150 but when the owner opened it afterwards it was found to be empty.

Another case was reported where a woman's finger appeared to have been cut off so that rings could be removed.

A fur coat was removed from a woman lying unconscious in the street.

Chief of Police Tanrahan last night said that while some looting was going on it was not serious. He issued a warning that most severe punishment will be meted out to any ghoul, who may be caught.
