

There are now 57 German and Austrian prisoners in the Vernon internment prison, and are housed in the building first used as a provincial jail and latterly as a branch of the Hospital for the Insane. They come principally from the Boundary and Kootenai districts. We are asked to mention the fact that a skating rink which has been formed on the grounds is not for the use of the general public, as some seem to imagine, but is reserved for prisoners and members of the B. C. Horse who are acting as guards.
