

# FOREIGNERS LEAVE WORK

## Work on South March Rifle Ranges Delayed.

It is reported that the Austrians and Poles employed in the construction work of the new rifle range, Kingscourt Park, at South March, are leaving to the number of twenty or thirty every day. The full complement of 250 has been reduced already to less than 150. Difficulty is being experienced with the men who are leaving, for they demand their wages in full without giving any previous notice of their intentions and the money is not always available. In many cases the wages have been paid in part, at least, and the men have left at once for Montreal. In those cases where the wages could not be paid the men have borrowed from their fellow-countrymen, so that they could accompany them back to the Old Country. It is possible that owing to the general shortage of money the work may be discontinued entirely within a few days.
