

RAISE NEW FORCE 100,000; AUGMENT N.W.M.P. TO 3,000

THOUSANDS OF WINNIPEGGERS
URGE THESE STEPS ON DO-
MINION GOVERNMENT.

(Special Despatch to The Globe.)

Winnipeg, Aug. 27.—More than six thousand citizens of Winnipeg gained admittance to and as many more were turned away to-night from the public war meeting called by Mayor Deacon, at which resolutions were unanimously adopted calling on the Dominion Government to augment the militia for home defence or possible foreign service by recruiting a new force of at least 100,000 men, also to augment the strength of the Northwest Mounted Police to at least 3,000 men for service between the Great Lakes and the Pacific coast.

Mayor Deacon presided, and the chief speakers were: Sir Hugh John Macdonald, A. M. Nanton, Sir Douglas Cameron, W. B. Lanigan, and E. McGrath, ex-President of the Trades and Labor Council.

BIG OFFICIALS ARRESTED.

Cape Town, Aug. 27.—Dr. Rudolf Karlova, Minister of Lands in German Southwest Africa, and Baron Victor Kraus, Lieutenant in the Austrian army, have been arrested and sent to Bloemfontein as prisoners of war.

TWO AIRMEN KILLED.

Paris, Aug. 27.—An army Lieutenant aviator and his pilot, whose names are suppressed under the rule of the Minister of War, were killed to-day in the fall of their machine at Juvisy.
