

# OTTAWA FOREIGNERS RUSH TO BECOME NATURALIZED NOW

Three Germans and one Austrian are included in the list of twenty-eight names which will be presented to the Court of Assize by Clerk Horace Pratt for naturalization on Monday, October 26. The balance of the list is made up of twenty-three Russians and one Japanese.

The list is an unusually heavy one, and as a number of the men are army reservists the present war probably accounts for the rush to become naturalized.

The Germans who have applied for naturalization are John Melesky, contractor; Paul Frederick, electrician; Walter Stemp, bookkeeper. Julius Gassener, waiter, has also applied, as have Professor Laing, dancing teacher, a native of Libeaux, Russia, and Mike Monta, valet, a Japanese.
