

25,000 Alien Enemies Have Registered

Ottawa, Nov. 26.—The registration of alien enemies in Canada will not be completed for several weeks yet, but 25,000 have already been registered and over 1,000 Germans, Austrians and Turks interned. Hon. J. G. Foster, United States consul-general for Canada at Ottawa, who is acting for the governments of Germany and Austria, is caring for the interests of those who are being made prisoners of war. He is being consulted by the government concerning the plans for their detention and the employment that is to be found for them.

Quebec has agreed to have the alien enemies who are detained in that province set to work cutting firewood and clearing up forest lands that would be suitable for settlement. It is expected that some of the prisoners may take up homesteads.

The Ontario government has not been heard from, but it is expected that a similar arrangement will be made with it.
