

MAN ARRESTED WAS NOT
CARL SCHMIDT BUT WAS
STILL VERY MUCH WANTED

Windsor, Aug. 31.—The man arrested on Bois Blanc Island yesterday by Detectives Nash and Smith was not Carl Schmidt, as the morning papers have the name, but Charles Respa, whom the police have been trying to secure ever since the dynamite explosion at Walkerville two months ago.

In the police court at Walkerville this morning Respa was arraigned and heard the charges of conspiring to dynamite the Peabody factory and the actual commission of that crime read over to him without making comment.

He was remanded eight days to allow the crown to collect evidence.
