

NEW CENSORSHIP REGULATIONS NOW UNDER DISCUSSION

May Deal With Papers Publishing Articles Detrimental to Cause of Allies

Ottawa, April 10.—Certain amendments to the censorship regulations are under consideration by the Censorship Committee of Canada. The nature of these changes has not yet been made known but it is believed they will strengthen the hands of the chief press censor in dealing with newspapers which in his opinion transgress the law by the publication of articles calculated to injure the cause of Britain and her allies in this country.
