

# WORKING OUT A PLAN TO HELP UNEMPLOYED

Government Will See That No  
Citizen in B. C. Lacks Neces-  
sities of Life.

Vancouver, Dec. 11.—Attorney-Gen-  
eral Bowser and Hon. H. W. Ross leave  
Sunday for a tour of the Kootenay.  
Hon. Mr. Bowser stated today that the  
government was working out a plan  
to relieve the unemployed, and will be  
ready for action early in the New Year.

The government, he said, will see  
that no citizen is compelled to go with-  
out the necessities of life in British  
Columbia. As a matter of fact they  
have been doing something already in  
a quiet way. In the strike zone on  
Vancouver Island they are providing  
for 220 families, many of them among  
those affected by the riots of a year  
ago.
