

CANADA WILL ACT PROMPTLY

If New Pro-German Campaign In
The United States Spreads Here.

Ottawa, Ont., June 11.—The new pro-German campaign disclosed in the United States whereby insidious attempts are being made by paid agents to create dissension and strikes among the workers in the munition factories is being watched carefully on this side of the border. It is considered by no means inconceivable that like efforts may be made in Canada to hamper and delay work on munition and other war supplies, and while no definite evidence has been secured to indicate that such efforts are being made any attempts will be promptly nipped in the bud as soon as discovered.

If suspicions should be well founded the agitators will be interned. In the Fernie Mines there has been

some trouble because of the presence there of about 150 Germans and Austrians. The men of allied nationality demanded their dismissal and to enforce the demands a strike was called. It is expected that the situation will be satisfactorily adjusted.
