

FERNIE COKE TO GO VIA NEW WESTMINSTER

Granby Company Transfers Its Business Owing to Trouble at Seattle.

NEW WESTMINSTER, Oct. 25.—Coke for the Anyox smelters, which comes from Fernie and was formerly shipped via Seattle, will henceforth go through this port. Owing to labor troubles in the Sound city, the Granby Mining & Smelting Company, has decided to transfer this business, and is making the necessary arrangements, which include the construction of an electrically driven conveyor for loading the coke from the cars to the barges. This is now being built on the G. N. dock by the Star Shipyards, and will be completed next week.

The Granby people will ship 3000 tons a month, involving a hundred cars and two barges.
