

FERNIE MINERS INDIGNANT

Work or Fight Order Does Not Appeal at All to Members of Union.

FERNIE, B. C., Oct. 22.—The members of the Fernie Miners' Union are very indignant over the recent no-strikes order of the Dominion government and at mass meeting passed a resolution of condemnation, and ordered that a copy be sent to the Trades and Labor Congress of Canada, together with an expression of disapproval that that body "has not shown itself worthy of confidence by its neglect to take drastic action in the face of such an autocratic order by the cabinet of Canada."

The circulars sent out with this resolution to all organized bodies after bitterly protesting against the order and soliciting immediate concerted action, concludes with "If we submit to such an order-in-council being passed without protest, no organization will be necessary, because we shall revert back to abject slavery."
