

TO FREE 1,000 INTERNED ALIENS FOR MINE WORK

OTTAWA, May 29.—Owing to the requirements of coal mining and pulp companies in Nova Scotia, Alberta and British Columbia, it has been decided to release approximately 1,000 interned aliens. These are men who were interned at the opening of the war her, on account of thir inability to make a living rather than because of any hostile intentions of their part. Instead of continuing to be an expense to the community they will henceforth contribute to its indusrial welfare.
