

# IMMIGRANTS ARE STILL POURING IN

## Nearly 4,000 New Arrivals in the Province of Ontario This Month.

Toronto, May 15. — Nearly 4,000 foreign immigrants off the s.s. Mount Royal and Koeln from Antwerp arrived in Toronto in three special trains.

The new arrivals were mostly Russians and Balkan peoples, although among them were some of the better class of German settlers for the West.

Fully half of the number continued their journey westward to Saskatchewan, where they will be employed at construction work on the G. T. P. Of the remainder, a large number were sent to North Bay, also for railroad construction work, and some will work on the new C.P.R. Toronto to Ottawa line.

The ss. Corsican has docked at

Quebec, while the Teutonic, Scandinavian and Empress of Ireland are on the St. Lawrence and the passengers are expected in Toronto to-morrow. The Empress of Ireland, which should have docked last Friday, was delayed by an accident to her engines.

Nearly 4,000 immigrants for Ontario have arrived so far this month. The demand for farm laborers continues undiminished.
