

# 65 FOREIGNERS LEAVE FOR TIMMINS

## Where, It is Said, They Will Engage in T. & N. O. Construction Work.

The departure of some 65 foreigners from the city yesterday to engage in construction work on the T. & N. O. at Timmins, led a number of Societes to believe that these men were bound for the mines at Porcupine where a strike is now going on. It was believed that the men were being pushed in as strike breakers.

The local ticket offices inform the Star that these men had nothing to do with the strikes at the point mentioned, that they comprised all nationalities, and that they would engage in railway work only.

These men have no connection with the Italians who left yesterday for New York, where they will embark for Italy following a notice from the Motherland calling out the reserves.
