

EUROPEAN UNREST PROMPTS PEOPLE TO COME TO CANADA

London, May 22.—The general opinion is that European unrest is driving the well-to-do artisan and small shop-keeper to seek homes in the New World. Manager Patron, of the White Star Line, said:—

"To my mind the exodus means that hundreds and thousands of good respectable Europeans with modern means have determined to turn their goods into cash and become residents and citizens of Canada and the United States. These men are not of the steerage type, who leave only to amass enough money to return. They are sober, industrious people, for whom the social and economic struggles of Europe have no further interest, and they will make good citizens wherever they go.

"The majority are going to Canada. Our boats on the Canadian service are packed, but there are also thousands landing in New York to seek opportunities in the United States. They are an entirely new class of emigrants."

Another steamship manager:—

"I believe that the colonial agents are chiefly responsible. The urgent campaign of Canadian advertising in the last year is now having its effect."
