

FOREIGNERS ENTERING UNDER FALSE PRETENCES

**TWO MEN FINED \$25 EACH, BUT
HAVING NO MONEY MAY GO
TO JAIL.**

Niagara Falls, Ont., March 27.—
Charged with entering **Canada** under
false pretences, Chanus Masegian, of
Erie, Pa., and Mike Bedrosian, of
Eleventh street, Niagara Falls, N. Y.,
were fined \$25 and costs each, with
the option of thirty days in the coun-
ty jail, by Magistrate Fraser this
morning.

The **foreigners** came across the
river on a Michigan Central train
last night. They had tickets to De-
troit. Inspector Craig followed the
men. At Welland they left the train,
and the Inspector caused their arrest.
Neither man had any money, and un-
less friends come to their rescue they
will spend the next month behind the
bars.
